Following being on chemo, Revlimid, for the second time, I had another itchy reaction. Called the doctor 14 days into my 21-day cycle, and he said quit the chemo immediately. Fortunately, the itchy rash went away rather quickly. Good thing, because we wanted to go to Virginia in early October to celebrate two of my grandkid's birthday. Bre, my oldest, turned 10 on October 11<sup>th</sup>. Colton, my youngest, turned 5 on October 9<sup>th</sup>. It was great to see the grandkids, and as we all say, they are growing up way too fast.

On October 10<sup>th</sup>, I had labs, then a doctor visit October 19<sup>th</sup>. The lab results were wonderful. Even though I did not finish the 21-day cycle, the Revlimid really brought my numbers down, in fact this was the lowest they have ever been. Great, great news, thank you Jesus. But the doctor continued saying he wanted to try Revlimid again. I kind of figured he would say that, since my numbers were so good. But because I had an allergic reaction, the doctor said he wants me to take the Revlimid for one week, then off for one week, and see what happens. If I have an allergic reaction, I am to call him right away. So, on October 23<sup>rd</sup>, I started back on Revlimid. Please pray that this arrangement works, with no adverse reaction but still take my numbers down.

I want to thank each of you for your many prayers, throughout my ordeal. I know it has been a long struggle, but in the end, God will make His plans known to us, and I pray that will mean remission for me. I continually pray for St. John and her new Pastor Mugnolo, that together you will accomplish the Mission of our Lord Jesus Christ. Pastor Jim
