The Bible in 180 Days

An Extraordinary Experience with the Word of God

The Bible holds riches untold and for the most part untapped for many Christians. That's why Pastor Jim is challenging the whole congregation of St. John Lutheran Church to commit to reading through the Bible, from cover to cover, in 180 days, as we begin the New Year 2016. This is a huge challenge, but one that is very possible if you agree to put aside the time and effort to do so daily.

Each day, Pastor Jim has identified 6 to 9 chapters of the Bible to read. Each Sunday, Pastor Jim will review what was read the previous week and answer any questions you might have from your weekly reading. This is your chance to join fellow believers of St. John to have an ***extra-ordinary experience with God's Word that will change your life forever.***

In the 180 day period, Pastor Jim has also identified 5 "Catch up Days" or "Free Days" where you can take a break without feeling guilty. These days are listed at the end of the schedule of reading.

Will you commit to reading through God's Word in 180 days? If so, watch for a coming commitment form, which you will make to God, ***and God alone,*** that you will give Him priority in your life starting January 3rd, 2016.

Walk through the Bible Class

In December, we continue our study of the New Testament Books, particularly the Gospels. Our Walk through the Bible Class will meet most Tuesdays in December at 1 or 7 PM. **There will not be class on December 29th.**

As we study the New Testament, this would be a good time to reconsider your participation in this class. If you have not been involved so far, I would personally ask you to think about joining our study. If you decide to join us for the first time, simply let Pastor Jim know, so that ample amount of materials can be prepared. Thank you.


